
## Gulfton



The Gulfton Super Neighborhood is located in southwest Houston, just outside the 610 Loop, and south of US-59. It is the heart of a diverse international community that is home to over 40,000 residents, almost six out of every ten residents were born outside the United States. The neighborhood encompasses an area of approximately 3 square miles, and is bounded by Southwest Freeway to the north, Chimney Rock to the east, Bellaire Boulevard and Bissonnet Street to the south, and Hillcroft Avenue to the west.

The income of our families is declining and the percent of families living in poverty is increasing


Our community continues to be a neighborhood of renters, and 96% of all housing units are rentals
