

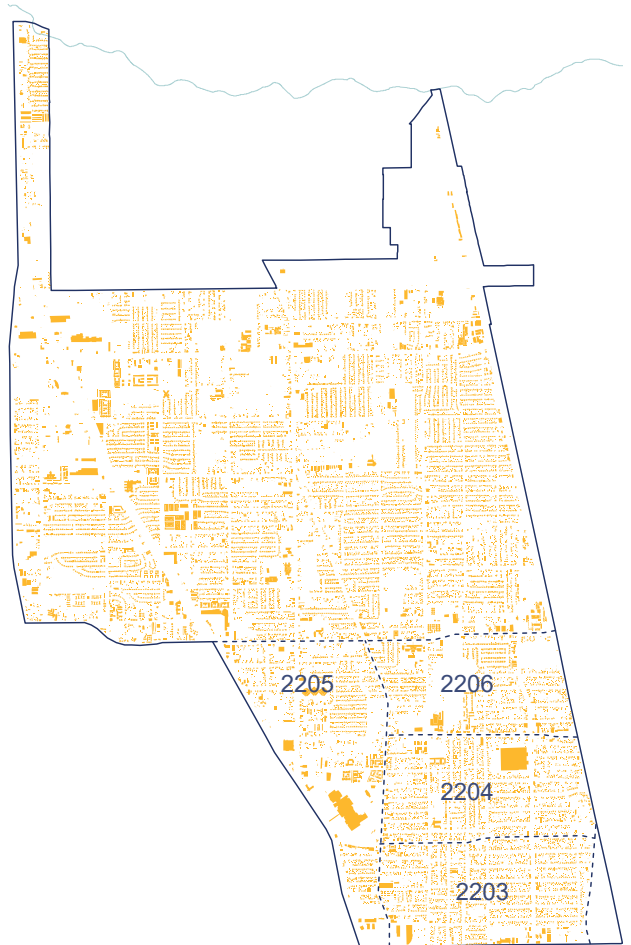
Northline



Greater Houston

The Northline Super Neighborhood is located approximately 4 miles north of Downtown, Houston. Overall, the neighborhood encompasses an area of approximately 10 square miles, and is bounded by Canino Road to the north, Hardy Toll Road to the east, the Burlington Northern railroad line to the south, and I-45 and North Shepherd to the west. The focus area for this Neighborhood Profile is south of Tidwell Road.

Our community is home to fewer children and more seniors



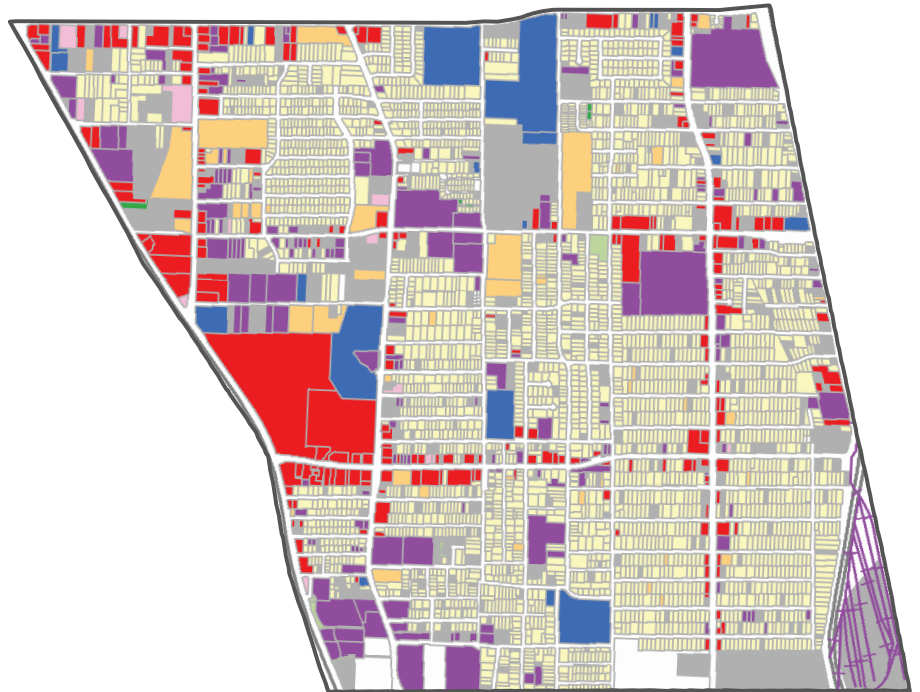
